Proposition 4

Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area **Public Safety Improvements** **\$3,400,000**

These bonds would pay for capital improvements to upgrade the generator at the Downtown Headquarters, replace the station gate, south entrance Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance, and renovate the heating delivery system all at the Anchorage Police Department (APD) Elmore Station, and upgrades for ADA compliance at the Jewel Lake Training Center within the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area.

Project Descriptions

APD Downtown Headquarters Generator Upgrade - \$1,500,000

Design and upgrade of the generator system to ensure reliable operation, improved performance, and compliance with current standards.

APD Elmore Station Gate Replacement - \$300,000

Replace the existing horizontal gates with vertical gates, ensuring reliable operation and enhanced security for the facility.

APD Elmore Station Heating Delivery System Renovation - \$1,500,000

Design and renovate the heating delivery system to ensure efficient, reliable, and cost-effective heating throughout the facility.

APD Elmore Station South Entrance ADA Upgrades - \$50,000

Renovate the entrance to ensure it is fully ADA compliant, providing equal access to all personnel and visitors.

APD Jewel Lake Training Center ADA Upgrade - \$50,000

Renovate the entrance to ensure it is fully ADA compliant, providing equal access to all personnel and visitors.
